

Construction Update, July 2009

I-15

July 6-22: Crews will shift I-15 traffic to the fast lane to remove and replace the slow lane half of the northbound bridge decks at Utah Avenue and 400 North.

July 27-August 20: Crews will shift I-15 traffic to the slow lane to remove and replace the fast lane half of the northbound bridge decks at Utah Avenue, 400 North and Payson Main Street.

Payson Main Street Bridge Area

July 31: Payson Main Street will be closed, under the bridge, for less than 20 hours during off-peak traffic times, to demolish the fast lane half of the northbound bridge deck.

400 North Bridge Area

July 8: Crews will close 400 North from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. to demolish the slow lane half of the northbound bridge deck. Traffic under the bridge will be reduced to one lane during the day. Flaggers will direct the flow of traffic.

July 29: Crews will close 400 North from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. to demolish the fast lane half of the northbound bridge deck. Traffic under the bridge will be reduced to one lane during the day. Flaggers will direct the flow of traffic.

Utah Avenue Bridge Area

July 7: Utah Avenue will be closed from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. to demolish the slow lane half of the northbound bridge deck. Traffic under the bridge will be reduced to one lane during the day. Flaggers will direct the flow of traffic.

July 28: Crews will close Utah Avenue from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. to demolish the fast lane half of the northbound bridge deck. Traffic under the bridge will be reduced to one lane during the day. Flaggers will direct the flow of traffic.

Detour Routes

Noise and Lights

Bridge demolition work will occur during daytime and nighttime hours. Residents near the bridges will experience noise impacts and shining lights. Activities will include jack hammering, operating heavy equipment, back beepers and night lighting. Permits are in place and authorities have been notified. We apologize for the inconvenience.

Speeds and Safety

Speeds on I-15 will be reduced from 75 mph to 65 mph during construction. Advisory speeds will be posted at 55 mph. Please slow down and use caution when driving through the work zone.

Independence Day Holiday

There will be no impact on I-15 during the Independence Day holiday from July 2 to July 6 at 9 p.m.
